WHEREAS on the 11th day of May 2018, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently residing in the East Coast Forensic Hospital on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 14th day of November 2023 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused initially, but the length of the restriction was excessive.
