**DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May 2018, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently residing in the East Coast Forensic Hospital on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of November 2023 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused initially, but the length of the restriction was excessive.
