DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 9th day of November, 2023, the accused was found unfit to stand trial on charges of mischief, contrary to s. 430(4), at large on undertaking fail to comply, contrary to s. 145(4)(A) x 11, at large on release order fail to comply, contrary to s. 145(5)(a) x 4, assault, contrary to s. 266 x 4, uttering threats, contrary to s. 264.1(1)(a), assault a peace officer, contrary to s.270(1)(a), assault with a weapon, contrary to s. 267(a), and theft under \$5000.00, contrary to s. 334(b) of the Criminal Code of Canada;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 8th day of January 2024 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be detained with a ceiling level of privileges of L4;

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).

The Board also finds that the accused is unfit to stand trial.
