

IN THE MATTER OF the Nova Scotia Criminal Code Review Board

AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, **Rylie McKelvie**

AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to Section 672.82(1) (Discretionary Hearing) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 2nd day of November 2023, the accused was found *Unfit to Stand Trial* on charges of: **Assault with a Weapon** contrary to s.267(a) and on a charge of **Aggravated Assault** contrary to s.268(1) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the accused presently resides at in the community.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 11th day of August, 2026 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused **continue** to be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
2. Maintain good mental health;

3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
4. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Community Program;
5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
6. Abstain from alcohol, cannabis and/or illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
7. Reside in the premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital which has 24/7 staffing and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
9. Appear before the Board when requested;
10. Remain within the Province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been received from the Board;
11. Any medical or mental health consultations are to be initiated or conducted by the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital;
12. Community passes with, or visitation at the accused's residency by, individuals other than from the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital or JAZ require approval by the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital. Requests for same are to be submitted to the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital at least one clear business day before the proposed time of such pass or visit. These requests may be submitted through a dedicated Smartphone to be established for such purpose;
13. Any complaints respecting JAZ, the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital, or members or employees thereof are to be submitted or forwarded to counsel for the accused (Kelly Rowlett, K.C.) and shall be addressed if deemed necessary by such counsel.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered to

the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
