DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 2nd day of November 2023, the accused was found unfit to stand trial on charges of assault with a weapon, contrary to s.267(a), and aggravated assault, contrary to s.268(1) of the Criminal Code of Canada;

AND WHEREAS the accused is residing currently on an inpatient unit at the Abbie J. Lane Hospital;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 16th day of January 2024 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
- 4. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Community Program;
- 5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
- 6. Abstain from alcohol, cannabis and/or illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;

7. Reside in the premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;

8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change

of address;

9. Appear before the Board when requested;

10. Remain within the Province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has

been received from the Board; and

11. Not possess any weapons as defined by the Criminal Code.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section

672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this

disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered

to the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova

Scotia.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program,

Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this

Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the

liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).

The Board also finds that the accused is unfit to stand trial.
