DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 8 th day of January 2025, the accused was found Not Criminally Responsible on account of a mental disorder on charges of: Causing a Disturbance, contrary to s.175(1), and on a charge of Uttering Threats, contrary to s.264(1) of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND whereas the Accused is residing in the community on continuous overnight passes but is considered an inpatient;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 20th day of January, 2026, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be discharged absolutely.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order.
