DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 24th day of November 2020, the accused was found *Not Criminally Responsible on account of a mental disorder* on charges of possession of weapon for dangerous purpose, contrary to Section 88(1); and breach of probation, contrary to Section 733.1(1)(a) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently residing in the community.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held via Zoom at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the ^{15th March} ~~16th~~ day of September 202⁵ to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be discharged absolutely. The restriction of liberties is accordingly moot.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order.
