DISPOSITION ORDER (Amended December 10, 2022)

WHEREAS on the 24th day of November 2020, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose contrary to section 88(1) of the Criminal Code and a charge of breach of probation contrary to section 733.1(1)(a) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused presently resides in the community on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 12th day of July 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused continue to be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 1. Maintain good mental health;
- 2. Adhere to the recommendations of the Forensic Team, including the need for psychoeducational counselling;
- 3. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Team;
- 4. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Team;
- 5. Abstain from alcohol, cannabis (unless he can produce a prescription for medical

cannabis) and/or illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;

6. Reside in the premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;

raise and regulations of the residence,

7. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;

8. Appear before the Board when requested;

9. Remain within the Province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been

received by the Board; and

10. No weapons as defined in the Criminal Code.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered to the East Coast

Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

The Board also finds that the restriction of liberties was justified.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
