

**IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD**  
**AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, Bradley MacIntyre**  
**AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to Section 672.81(1) (Annual**  
**Hearing) of the Criminal Code**

**DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 31st of July, 2017, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of a mental disorder on charges of harming animals that are not cattle, contrary to s. 445(a); assault, contrary to s. 266; assault with a weapon, contrary to s. 267(), assault on a police officer with a weapon, contrary to s. 270.01(1)(a) (x2), possession of a weapon, contrary to s. 88(1); unlawful confinement, contrary to s. 297(2), and uttering threats, contrary to s. 264.1(1)(a) – all references are to the Criminal Code of Canada;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is residing currently detained on Unit A, after having been incarcerated at the Central Nova Scotia Correctional Facility, and is the subject of a Board detention order with a ceiling of L4;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on February 11, 2025 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.81 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED** that the accused continue to be detained in the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital, with a community access level of L4.

**AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered to the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
