## **DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 2022, the accused was found *Not Criminally Responsible* on account of a mental disorder on charges of: Robbery contrary to Section 344; Uttering Threats contrary to Section 264.1(1)(a) x2; Breach of Undertaking contrary to Section 145(4)(a); and on a charge of Assault contrary to Section 266 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is presently residing at Simpson Landing on an L6 continuous overnight community access level.

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 4<sup>th</sup> of April, 2023 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be discharged absolutely.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order.
