## **DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 10th day of September 2019, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of assault with a weapon contrary to section 267(A) of the Criminal Code, occurring on May 21, 2019, in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a Board granted ceiling level of privileges of L6;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 12th day of October 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of Ms. Panisiak.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
