

**IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD**  
**AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, HENRY JAMESON PRIME**  
**AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81(2.1) of the Criminal Code**

**DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2014, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of transporting a firearm in a careless manner, contrary to section 86(1) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 14th day of December, 2015, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED** that the conditional discharge previously granted be continued, on the following terms:

1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
2. Maintain good mental health;
3. Adhere to the recommendations of the community mental health team;
4. Comply with follow up by the forensic community program;
5. Comply with conditions recommended by the forensic community program;
6. Abstain from the use of alcohol and illegal drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
7. Notify the Board and the hospital of any change in address;
8. Appear before the Board when requested;
9. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing from the Board has been obtained.
10. Reside in premises approved by the hospital.

The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director of the Mental Health Program, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to him under section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits and subject to the conditions set out in this order.
