## **DISPOSITION ORDER**

WHEREAS on the 12th day of June 2015, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of theft under \$5000, contrary to section 334(b) of the Criminal Code and possession of property obtained by crime, contrary to section 355 of the Criminal Code (both related to May 9, 2014), a charge of theft under \$5000 contrary to section 334(b) of the Criminal Code and possession of property obtained by crime, contrary to section 355 of the Criminal Code (both charges relating to May 13, 2014) and robbery, contrary to section 344 of the Criminal Code (relating to May 19, 2014);

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently residing in the hospital on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 16th day of March 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the accused continue to be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;

4. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Community Program;

5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;

6. Abstain from alcohol, cannabis and/or illicit drugs and comply with random urine

drug screening;

7. Reside in the premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and

abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;

8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change

of address;

9. Appear before the Board when requested;

10. Remain within the Province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has

been received from the Board.

The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restrictions the liberties of Mr.

Sabourin.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program,

Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this

Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the

liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
