DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 30th day of June 2020, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of a mental disorder on charges of two counts of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1(1)(a) of the Criminal Code; and a charge of criminal harassment, contrary to section 264(2)(b) of the Criminal Code of Canada;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently residing at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a ceiling level of privileges of L4;


AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 15th day of June 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused continue to be detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a ceiling level of privileges of L6;

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
