IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, JUSTIN SHEWCHUK AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81 (2.1) (Restriction of Liberties) of the Criminal Code

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 12th of December 2018, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of trespassing at night, contrary to Section 177 of the Criminal Code and three charges of failure to comply with a recognizance or undertaking, contrary to Section 145(3) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently residing at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held 20th day of December 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
