DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 1st day of June, 2021, the accused was found Not Criminally Responsible on account of a mental disorder on a charge of assault with a weapon, contrary to Section 267(a); mischief, contrary to Section 430(4); and everyone who commits an offence who carries or possesses a weapon, contrary to Section 88(2) of the Criminal Code of Canada;

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently residing in the community.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held via Zoom at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 18th day of August, 2025 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be discharged absolutely.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order.
