

**IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD
AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, Steven Terry
AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to Section 672.47(1) (First Hearing
of the Criminal Code**

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 2nd day of December 2025, the accused was found *Unfit to Stand Trial* on charges of:

Theft Under \$5000 contrary to s.334(B) and on a charge of At Large on Confirmed Undertaking, Fails to Appear contrary to s. 145(4)(B) and on a charge of At Large on Confirmed Undertaking, Fails to Comply with Condition contrary to s.145(4)(A) x3 and on a charge of Having Appeared, Fails to Subsequently Attend Court as Directed contrary to s.145(2)(B); and on a charge At Large on Release Order, Fails to Attend contrary to s.145(2)(A); and on a charge of At Large on Release Order, Fails to Comply with Condition contrary to s. 145(5)(A) x2 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 12th day of January 2026, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

IT IS ORDERED that the accused be detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital with a community access ceiling level of L3, as currently defined.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered to the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).

The Board also finds that the accused remains unfit to stand trial.
