

IN THE MATTER OF the Nova Scotia Criminal Code Review Board

AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, Tevin Delorey-TOUSSAINT

AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to Section 672.47 (1) (First hearing) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 11th day of June 2025, the accused was found *Unfit to Stand Trial* on charges of: Breach of Probation contrary to s.733.1(1) x 187 and on a charge of Resists/Obstructs Peace Officer contrary to s. 129(A) x4 and on a charge of Theft under \$5000 contrary to s. 334(B) x90 and on a charge of Possession Under contrary to s. 355(B) x91 and on a charge of Robbery contrary to s. 344(B) and on a charge of Fails to Comply with Conditions contrary to s. 145(5)(A) x4 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 21st day of July 2025 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

IT IS ORDERED that the accused continue to be detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital with a Board community access ceiling level of L4.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered to the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).

The Board also finds that the accused remains unfit to stand trial.
