AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to Section 672.47 (1) (First Hearing) of the Criminal Code of Canada.

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 26th day of August 2024, the accused was found Not Criminally Responsible on account of a mental disorder on charges of: Assault Causing Bodily Harm contrary to s.267(b); and on a charge of Assault with a Weapon contrary to s.267(a); and on a charge of Uttering Threats contrary to s. 264.1(1)(a); and on a charge of Mischief contrary to s. 430(4); and on a charge of Fail to Comply contrary to s. 145(4)(a); and on a charge of Attempt to Commit Murder contrary to s.239(b) of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 1 st day of October 2024, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a community access ceiling level of L5. It is further ordered that in addition to standard Hospital rules, the accused have no indirect or direct contact with the victim in

this matter, Chantelle Harker.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered to the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
