IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, JEREMY WILLIAMS AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81 (1) of the Criminal Code

## **DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 12<sup>th</sup> of March 2013, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder in Quebec on three charges of assault with a weapon, contrary to Section 267 of the Criminal Code; and on the 20<sup>th</sup> of March 2013, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder in Quebec on a charge of assault, contrary to Section 266 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at a federal correctional institution;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** a hospital detention order with a ceiling level of L1 be granted to be implemented upon his release from custody;

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
