

IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD

AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, MICHAEL WOLFE

AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81(1) of the Criminal Code

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 19th day of August, 2014, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on three charges of breach of probation, contrary to section 733.1 of the Criminal Code, and one charge of break and enter, contrary to section 348(1)(b) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained in hospital;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 4th day of May, 2015, to make an order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
2. Maintain good mental health;
3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
4. Comply with follow up by the Forensic Community Program;
5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
6. Abstain from the use of alcohol and illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;

7. Reside in premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
8. Notify the Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
9. Appear before the Board when requested;
10. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been received from the Board;
11. Do not initiate contact with Allison Tracey;
12. Do not possess any firearms as defined in the Criminal Code and do not transport in your vehicle anything that could be used as a weapon as defined in the Criminal Code.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Administrator of the East Coast Forensic Hospital, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order. The Board delegates to him under section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits and subject to the conditions set out in this order.
