DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 15th day of June 2018, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of assaulting a peace officer, contrary to section 270 (1)(a) of the Criminal Code, and on the 14th day of August 2018, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 17th day of July 2023 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be discharged absolutely.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order.
