WHEREAS on the 16th day of December 2022, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of aggravated assault, contrary to s.268(1) of the Criminal Code, possession of weapon for dangerous purpose, contrary to s.88(1) of the Criminal Code, assaulting a peace officer, contrary to s.270(1)(A) (x 2) of the Criminal Code, possessing a firearm while prohibited, contrary to s.117.01(1) of the Criminal Code, possession of a weapon or imitation, contrary to s. 87 of the Criminal Code and mischief, contrary to s.430(4) x3 of the Criminal Code of Canada;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with an L6 ceiling level of privileges;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 24th day of July 2023 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the restriction of liberties was justified.
