DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 13th day of May 2022, the accused was found Not Criminally Responsible on account of a mental disorder on charges of: Break and Enter contrary to Section 348(1)(a); False Alarm of Fire contrary to Section 437 x5; and further on a charge of Mischief contrary to Section 430(4) of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently residing in the Community.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 13th day of July, 2026 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the Criminal Code of Canada.

WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be discharged absolutely.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order.
