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In force date of regulations: As of November 28, 2023*, the date a regulation comes into force is determined by subsection 3(6) of the *Regulations Act*.

A regulation comes into force on the date it is filed unless the regulation states that it comes into force on a later date, or the Act that the regulation is made under authorizes the regulation to come into force on a date earlier than the date it was filed or authorizes another method of coming into force.

*Date that subsections 3(4) and (5) of Chapter 54 of the Acts of 2022, *An Act to Amend Chapter 393 of the Revised Statutes, 1989, the Regulations Act*, were proclaimed in force.

I, Brad Johns, Attorney General and Minister of Justice for the Province of Nova Scotia, pursuant to Section 8 of Chapter 450 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989, the *Summary Proceedings Act*, effective on and after the date of this order, hereby

- (a) amend Schedule 9A to the *Summary Offence Tickets Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 281/2011, made by order of the Attorney General and Minister of Justice dated October 4, 2011, to designate certain offences under the *Air Quality Regulations* as summary offence ticket offences, in the manner set forth in the attached Schedule “A”; and
- (b) order and direct that the penalty to be entered on a summons in respect of an offence set out in amendments to the schedules to the *Summary Offence Tickets Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 281/2011, as set forth in the attached Schedule “A”, is the out-of-court settlement amount listed in the out-of-court settlement column set out opposite the description for the offence, and includes the charge provided for in, and in accordance with, Sections 8 and 9 of the Act.

- 1 Subsection 18(6) of the regulations is amended by adding “if the expenditures are made within six months of the member being declared elected or by the end of the fiscal year during which the member was declared elected, whichever is later” immediately after “Commission”.
- 2 Subsection 27(5) of the regulations is amended by
 - (a) striking out “A newly elected” and substituting “An”; and
 - (b) adding “and the expenditures are made within six months of the member being declared elected or becoming an outside member or by the end of the fiscal year during which the member was declared elected or became an outside member, whichever is later” immediately after “accommodation” the last time it occurs.

ATTORNEY GENERAL ORDER**Pursuant to Section 4 of Chapter 393 of
the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989,
the *Regulations Act***

Whereas subsection 4(3) of the *Regulations Act* allows the Attorney General, on the recommendation of the Registrar of Regulations, to order the dispensation of the publication of a regulation in prescribed circumstances;

And Whereas the Municipal *Financial Reporting and Accounting Manual* and Schedules made by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing pursuant to Section[s] 451 [and 520] of Chapter 18 of the Acts of 1998, the *Municipal Government Act*, is of such length and complexity to render publication in the *Royal Gazette Part II* unpractical;

And Whereas the Registrar of Regulations has recommended dispensing with the publication of the Municipal *Financial Reporting and Accounting Manual* and Schedules in the *Royal Gazette Part II*;

Therefore, I Hereby Order the dispensation of the publication in the *Royal Gazette Part II* of the Municipal *Financial Reporting and Accounting Manual* and Schedules made under the *Municipal Government Act* by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing [by order] dated January 24, 2024.
