

CONFIDENTIALITY CAUTION

The Provincial Victim Services Program shall keep in confidence information disclosed by clients with the following exceptions:

1. If the Victim Services Officer has reason to believe a child or an adult is in need of protection, the Victim Services Officer is required by law to report the information to the proper authorities.
2. If the Victim Services Officer's client files are subpoenaed by the Court, the Victim Services Officer is required to provide relevant information to the Court.
3. If the Victim Services Officer has reason to believe that you or someone else may commit a crime or may be endangered, based on information you have disclosed, the Victim Services Officer is required to disclose this information to the proper authorities.
4. In cases of very serious domestic violence, the Provincial Victim Services Program is required to share critical information in order to help ensure your safety.
