## **Updates**

The Review Office is currently wrapping up FRPA Reviews and finalizing reports. These will be posted on the website at http://novascotia.ca/lae/RplLabour Mobility/FRPGuidelines.asp. Notification will be sent out when they go live.

The end of 2014 is approaching and so too is the next annual data submission. A few regulatory bodies still have not submitted 2013 data. Please ensure all data for 2013 is entered by September 30, 2014.

Some of the FRPA activities rely on support from the Federal IQR funding, a Federal/Provincial agreement that ended in March 2014. A new agreement has not yet been signed. Breakfast meetings will continue beginning October 1st (see details below). Once we have signed a new agreement IQR activities (including stakeholder project funding) will commence.
