WHO IS WORKING ON YOUR HOUSE

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT AND SYSTEMS

Electrical contractors working in your home are required to be trained and licensed and must follow provincial laws and national codes.





As a homeowner you are entitled and encouraged to ask electrical contractors the following questions:

- Do they have licensed electricians?
- Do they have an electrical wiring permit that was issued by the Inspection Authority? As a homeowner you can request a copy.
- What steps will they take to ensure your electrical systems or equipment are installed and working safely? For example, testing the proper function of ground fault circuit interrupters that are installed.
- Have all inspections by the inspection authority been completed? Homeowners are entitled to a copy of the inspection report which will confirm if the installation passed.

Be sure to ask for confirmation of training and licensing before the work is started.
