

Overview

The current Fuel Safety Online portal leverages NS Online, which will no longer be available. As such, a new Fuel Safety Online portal has been developed, which requires a "My NS Account" user account to access.

This guide will help a user set up an applicant profile for the new Fuel Safety Online portal and add a licence. It is intended for people who have existing "My NS Account" users and are accessing the new Fuel Safety Online portal for the first time.

Once the applicant profile has been created and the licence has been added, the Fuel Safety Installation Registration/Permit application process is the same as it has been previously.

Before starting, please have the following information available:

- "My NS Account" user and password
 - "My NS account" credentials are used access the Fuel Safety Online portal through the link provided
- Fuel Safety Company Licence number

Instructions

Access the New Fuel Safety Online Portal

1. Click on the <u>new</u> URL for the Fuel Safety Online portal. https://acp.novascotia.ca/novascotia/site/fuelSafetyPortal/fs_landingpage

Tip: Add a bookmark with the new URL or update your existing bookmark.

2. Click Login.









3. At the language selection page, select **English**.



4. In the "My NS Account" page, enter your username.




5. Click Continue.



6. Enter your password.




7. Click **Sign in**.



Create a Fuel Safety Online Applicant Profile


8. In the "Create Applicant Profile" page, complete all mandatory fields, which are indicated with a red asterisk (*).



For the phone number, use your work-related phone number. For the Civic and Mailing addresses, use the company's addresses.


Tip: If the company's mailing address is the same as the civic address, click on the "Mailing address same as Civic address" checkbox, which can be found right below the Mailing Address header.

9. Click **Create Profile**. This will create an applicant profile, which represents the person applying on behalf of the company for a Fuel Safety Permit/Registration.




Add a Licence

10. In the "Applicant Profile" landing page, click **+Add a Licencee**.




11. In the "Add a Licencee" page, enter the Fuel Safety Company licence number.



12. Click Submit.




13. If the Fuel Safety Company licence and RJSC registration are both in good standing, the licence will be added to the "Applicant Profile" landing page.



Note: Adding the licence also includes important details about the licence. The status of the Fuel Safety Company Licence is "Issued". Right below, the expiry date is also listed, along with the RJSC Company status.


Submit an Application

14. Click **Start Application** to start filling in the application form.




15. In the first page, complete all relevant fields and click **Next**.




16. In the second page, complete all relevant fields and click **Next**.



17. In the third page, complete all relevant fields and click **Next**.




18. In the "Summary" page, verify the details of your application and click Next.




19. In the "Fee Confirmation" page:

- To proceed with your application and pay the application fee, click **Submit**.
- To make any chances to your application, click Back To Summary.
- To cancel your application, click Cancel Application.




20. In the payment page, enter the Card Number, Expiry Date, and Security Code. Then click **Pay Now**.




21. In the "Registration Confirmation" page:

- To go back to the Fuel Safety Online portal, click click here.




Update Applicant Profile


22. To make changes to the applicant profile, such as an address or phone number change, on the Applicant Profile landing page, click **Update Profile**.



23. In the "Applicant Profile Modify" page, change the necessary fields and click **Update Profile**.



In the example above, the phone number, civic address, and mailing address have changed.




In the "Applicant Profile" landing page, the civic address and phone number have been updated.
