## **Technical Safety Division is responsible for:**

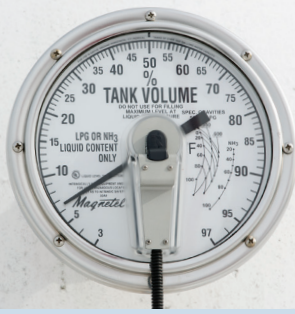
- Administering the *Technical Safety Act* and Fuel Safety Regulations
- Certifying regulated work, equipment and systems
- Performing inspection services
- Licensing and permitting

## Owners of Regulated Equipment are responsible to:

1. Ensure necessary permits are obtained for installation.
2. Report accidents involving regulated fuels within 24 hours.
3. Ensure contractors are properly licensed for the work being completed.
4. Schedule routine maintenance for equipment with qualified contractors.

## Fuel Contractors are responsible to:

1. Obtain necessary permits.
2. Report accidents involving regulated fuels within 24 hours.
3. Ensure compliance with the applicable codes and standards.
4. Ensure that all regulated work is conducted by a properly licensed contractor or technician registered with Technical Safety.
