### Release Notes for External Users

LaMPSS Release 5.6 mainly focused on migrating Immigration & Population Growth forms from NS Online to LaMPSS. The migration includes users and their submitted forms to provide a seamless transition from one system to another.

---

#### LaMPSS Online

- **New Immigration & Population Growth (IPG) Landing page** – to allow candidates, immigration representatives, and employers to access an IPG specific area of LaMPSS Online. All web sites that direct a user to apply will send them here.
- **New IPG Homepage** – to provide a tailored experience for candidates, immigration representatives, and employers to view history or create new forms.
- **New IPG Form History** – to provide access to forms that candidates, immigration representatives, and employers have in progress or have submitted in the past (including NS Online forms that have a recent decision or are still in progress).
- **New IPG Document Upload** – to provide the ability for candidates, immigration representatives, and employers to provide documents to IPG case managers when they need it.
- **New Immigration Representation Access form** – to allow an immigration representative to request ability to submit NSNP applications on behalf of their clients.
- **New NSNP Applications** – to allow candidates or their representatives to complete and submit NSNP applications.

#### LaMPSS Self-Serve

- **New Immigration Representative security role** – a new role is assigned to an Organization Contact that allows access to LaMPSS (not previously available to immigration representatives) and the ability to submit multiple NSNP applications on LaMPSS Online.
- **New configuration** - to allow immigration representatives to launch new NSNP applications, view their information, and view their in-progress forms.

## **Nova Scotia Online User Migration**

- **NS Online Users** – users that recently & successfully submitted forms or have an NSNP case in LaMPSS where a decision has recently been made or not made at all will be migrated to LaMPSS. They will not be able to edit the application forms but will be able to see history, upload documents if IPG requests document updates, and view the PDF application form created in Nova Scotia Online.

## **Service Registration**

- **Defect fixes addressing issues with the *Add New Participant* workflow** (errors when a merge was recommended and when buttons were clicked multiple times during processing delays—unnecessary buttons are now disabled), updating duplicated Individual Service participant schedules, and participant session pagination (all sessions are now displayed on a single page).
