

# LaMPSS Release 2.5

## Release Notes for External Service Providers

### Organization Funding Agreement Management

- ENHANCEMENT: TFS 7722 - Financial and Activity Reports now cannot be submitted before the end of the period that the report covers.
  - Accidentally submitting reports too early has been causing many problems for organizations, agreement managers and the LaMPSS support team, because once submitted, there is no way for the organization or agreement manager to correct or resubmit the information.
  - It is important to wait until the after the end of the reporting period covered so that the report can have complete and accurate information about the spending or activities that occurred during that period. Therefore, the system now does not accept reports before the end of the period covered.
  - For example, if the report covers activities or spending for March 1<sup>st</sup> through April 30<sup>th</sup>, and is due on May 10<sup>th</sup>, the report cannot be submitted before May 1<sup>st</sup>.

## External Case Management

- **NOC CODES**

- DATA FIX: TFS 8702 – Revert ECM NOC codes to 2006 version
  - In Release 2.1, we updated all NOC codes in Case Management to the 2011 version released by HRSDC. However, since the “Working in Canada” web site is still using the 2006 NOC version, and since Service Canada has not officially started using the new codes, we have decided to “roll back” the updates.
  - The NOC code picker will now show only the 2006 NOC codes, and all 2011 codes previously saved in cases will be converted back, if necessary, to the equivalent 2006 code.

- **Action Plan Details**

- Fixed Defect: TFS 7728 – when opening Action Plan Details screen, should not show warning message that more than 100 Business Partners found

- **Application Package**

- Fixed Defect: TFS 866 – misleading error message after cancelling or submitting Application Package
- Fixed Defect: TFS 7688 - On submit, if Delivering Org on the intervention is a private business partner, do *\*not\** add it to the agreement. If a private business partner is used on an application for funding, the agreement will come across to ENS with no delivering organization attached. Only public business partners are to be used in funding applications

- **Case Additional Info**

- Fixed Defect: TFS 8053 - unchecking selection for "In receipt of following benefits" did not properly save the changes. This is a background data fix and will not be visible to users.

- **Case Status**

- Enhancement - TFS 7378 - Added new status reason "Created in Error" when closing a case. It is appropriate to use this reason code to close a case in “Intake”, “Assessment” and possibly “RTWAP Development” ONLY. After the RTWAP has been agreed to and signed and the case is in “RTWAP Management” or “Follow-up” status it is not appropriate to close a case to “Created in Error”

- **ECM Case Workload Report**
  - Fixed Defect: TFS 7526 - last column wrapped to next page creating "almost-blank" double pages for the entire report
  - Fixed Defect: TFS 7716 - the summary counts by case manager were not accurate
- **ECM EAS Activity Report**
  - Enhancement: TFS 8703 - Changed label on "Total Ongoing" column to better describe that count is relative to date report is run, \*not\* count at end of reporting period. New label is: "Ongoing (as of report run date)"
- **ECM Person List Report**
  - Fixed Defect: TFS 8040 – "Employment Achieved" displayed incorrect count
  - Fixed Defect: TFS 8211 – Visible Minority column displayed incorrect count
