- Assign functional expertise to undertake Information Management/Information Technology related work.
  - (Jan. 16/09) Planning the technology infrastructure needed to connect LMDA staff to the provincial network for transition.
  - (Jan. 16/09) Connectivity work group to be set up in early February; several offices that might have co-location already have a provincial network feed to the building.
  - (Jan 16, 2008) Continuing to provide any needed changes to Service Canada systems for such basic requirements as cheque logos and text, and definition of new RC codes
  - (Jan. 16/09) Reviewing Adobe Acrobat forms in use at Service Canada; and assessing other local technology solutions in use in Nova Scotia for such requirements as tracking paper files.
  - (Jan. 16/09) Province to establish at least two Local Registration Authorities (PKI).
  - (Dec. 12/08) Confirmed that Nova Scotia will use the calculator, post transition, and that we will continue to use Contact IV
  - (Dec. 5/08) Completed arrangements to use relevant portions of the current federal technology solution, pending development of a long-term provincial technology solution.
- Provide all working groups with any Information Management/Information Technology assistance required during the Implementation Phase period, leading to July 1, 2009.

- Assists the Finance working group in the preparation of the Interim Corporate Management Agreement, as required.
  - (Jan. 16/09) Finalized the supplementary agreement including cash flow and three-year high-level vision of the Province's long-term technology solution.
