



CC Other Funding & Implementation

- Feasibility studies, Designs and Planning,
- Engagement and Education, and
- ▶ Innovative initiatives for low carbon solutions
- ▶ Does <u>not</u> fund capital costs for implementation



#### **Funding Disbursement**


- > 90% upon approval

# **Program Categories**

#### Clean Buildings - up to \$75,000

Think: Energy audits, design and deep retrofit plans.

#### Clean Electricity - up to \$75,000

Think: Plans or studies for community solar, net-metered solar or energy storage.

#### Clean Transportation - up to \$75,000

Think: Plans or studies for electric vehicle fleets or shared mobility services.

#### Clean Energy Education - up to \$50,000

Think: Staff training, capacity building, public engagement, workforce development or upskilling.

Learning by doing: Testing an innovative solution in one of the sectors (requires evaluation and knowledge transfer built into project).
