

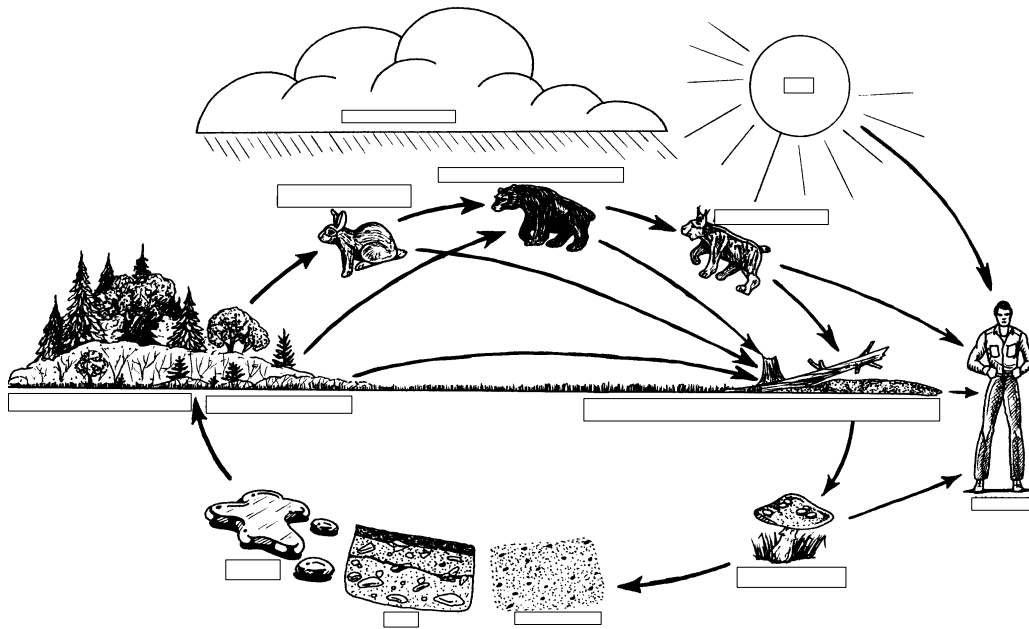

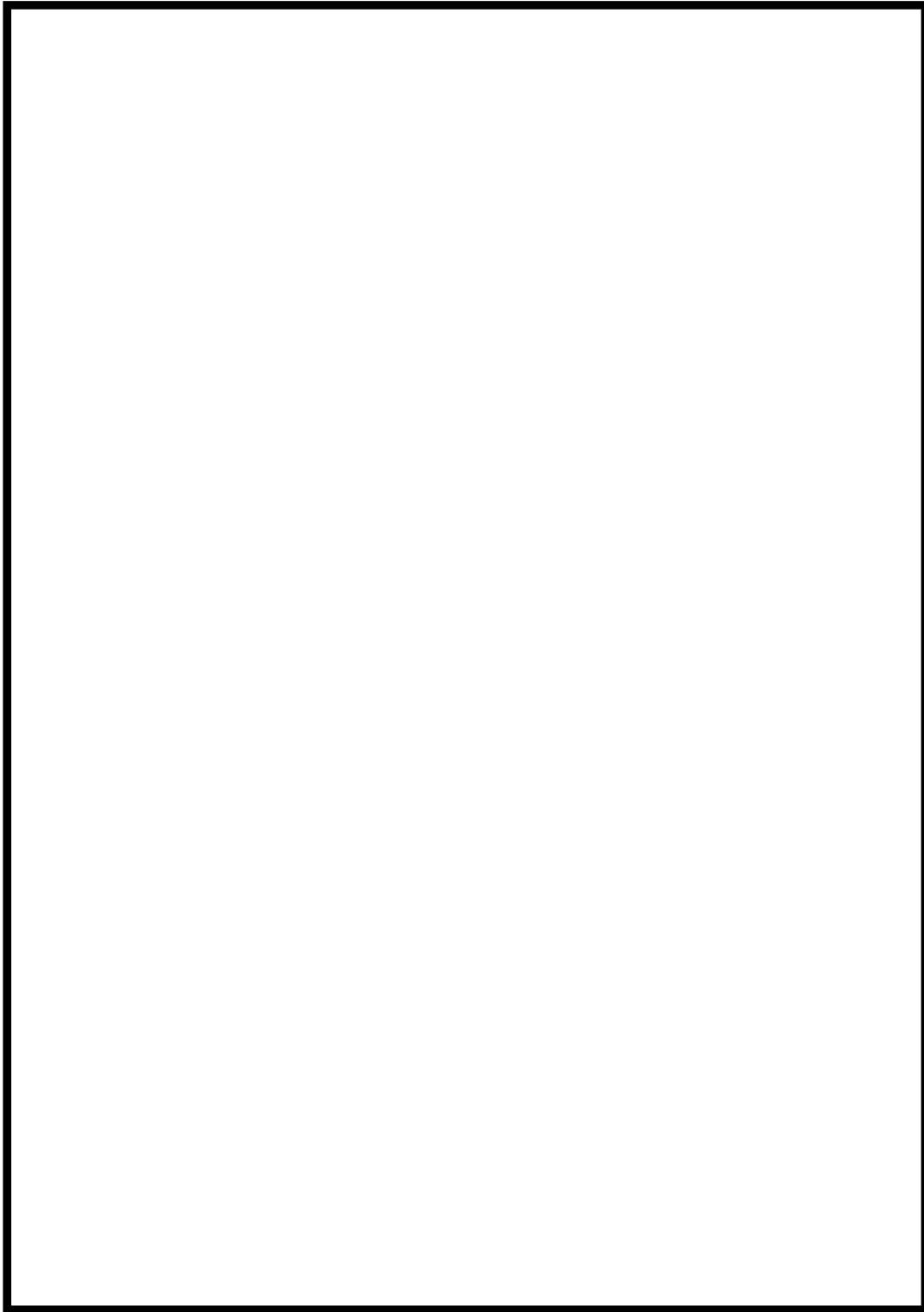
ENERGY FLOW IN A FOREST ECOSYSTEM
