

Abercrombie Wildlife Management Area



This Wildlife Management Area is mostly located on privately owned land at Abercrombie Point. It includes 138 hectares of land adjacent to the Neenah Paper mill. Of this, 45 hectares are urban, agriculture, roads or other human-influenced nonforested land. The remaining 93 hectares are forested with some small areas of water and wetland. In the 1970's a nature trail was established here. Use of the trail for recreation and education led to the area becoming a Wildlife Management Area in 1977. The Wildlife Management Area also includes a 1.8 hectare area of Pictou Harbour east of the Pictou causeway where a double-crested cormorant colony has become established on some old pilings. Hunting and trapping are prohibited.
