

Minas Basin Wildlife Management Area



This wildlife management area was established for the protection of migratory waterfowl, primarily Canada geese. It is made up of 126.8 hectares of privately owned land, which includes 119 hectares of farmland, 4.8 hectares of built-up land and 3.1 hectares of woodland, wetland and brush. The area is not particularly heavily used by waterfowl. Hunting and trapping are prohibited.
