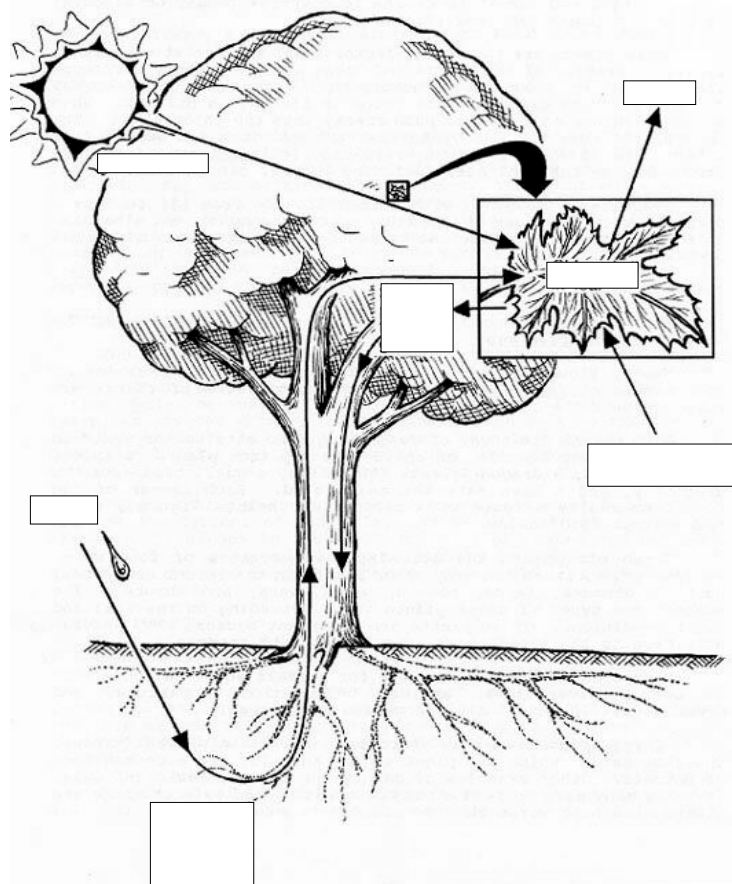
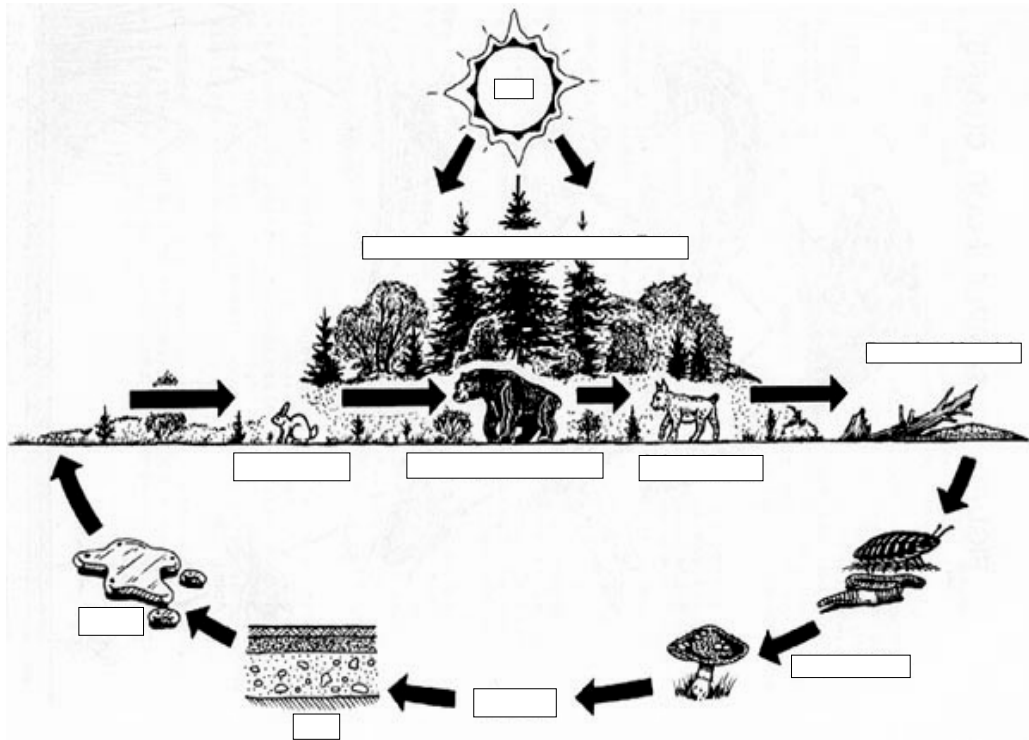


Exercise 3: Below are two illustrations of an energy flow and the photosynthesis process. Label the two diagrams by filling in the blanks provided. (see page 17)
