

Multi-Pher 1 Pheromone Trap

Used to Collect: Spruce Budworm (June to Sept.)
Hemlock Looper (Sept. to Oct.)
Whitemarked Tussock Moth (July to Oct.)

Components for each trap:

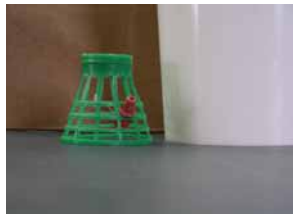
- 1 trap lid with hanging wire
- 1 shuttlecock
- 1 pheromone
- 1 funnel
- 1 Vaportape killing strip
- 1 trap bucket



Trap Assembly



Use latex gloves to handle Vaportape. Open the Vaportape envelope. Drop the Strip into the trap bucket. Place the funnel pointing down in to the bucket. The funnel rests on a ridge just below the holes at the top of the bucket.



Pheromones come in several different forms. They can be embedded in a small rubber cap or in a small cylinder of plastic. Carefully open the envelope containing the pheromone. If the pheromone is a rubber cap (WMTM, HL), push it through one of the small holes in the shuttlecock until it is secure. If it is the plastic cylinder (SBW), weave the attached plastic tag through the holes until secure.



There are two fittings in the trap lid. Snap the shuttlecock containing the pheromone into the small, middle fitting.

Place the trap bucket into the larger fitting and turn to secure.
