

Registry of Buyers - Report on Primary Forest Products Acquired and Business Summaries

Report FOR 2002- 4

1. This summary is published annually to report the statistical information related to the purchase of primary forest products, forest harvesting, and the production of secondary forest products in Nova Scotia. This information is collected from companies and individuals involved in the forest sector who acquire primary forest products.

Summary

The total provincial harvest for 2001 is reported to be 6 182 686 cubic metres of solid wood. Of this amount 86%, or 5 290 610 cubic metres, were softwood species. The total volume of wood exported was reported to be 1 104 189 cubic metres or 18% of the total harvest.

The provincial harvest for 2001 shows a decline of 5% when compared to the 2000 harvest of 6 471 675 cubic metres.

Statistical returns were received from 353 Registered Buyers. Data was estimated for 14 non-compliant buyers, for a total of 367 Registered Buyers. Of the 367 buyers, 293 were reported to be active in the 2001 calendar year.

WOOD ACQUISITION PLAN PROGRAM

Summary

The Wood Acquisition Program required by the Forest Sustainability Regulations completed the second year of operation in 2001. All Registered Buyers that acquired greater than 5,000 m³ from privately owned forest lands in Nova Scotia during the 2001 calendar year were required to submit a Wood Acquisition Plan for 70 percent of that volume in 2001. All compliant Registered Buyers opted for undertaking a silviculture program for the year 2001, and submitted a summary of completed silviculture (Form D, Part III) for claim in 2001 along with supporting silviculture site location details.

The volumes from 2001 that required a Wood Acquisition Plan totaled 3.749 million cubic metres based on 70% phase-in requirement (Table 1). From those volumes, a total of 10.016 million silviculture credit value was required in year 2001, and the summary reports indicated that 13.462 million silviculture credits were claimed (Table 1). In comparison to year 2000, required silviculture Credit increased by 160% and completed silviculture claimed increased by 63% in 2001. Industrial silviculture credits completed again far exceeded credits required in 2001 (Table 1). Private silviculture credit value claimed narrowly exceeded credits required by 57,161, and completed hardwood silviculture on both Industrial and Private landowners exceeded credit value required (Table 1).

A total of 32,446 hectares of silviculture for a credit value of 13.462 million were claimed in 2001 (Table 2). Established Plantation (Category 2), recorded the most area claimed at 33% which accounted for 51% of total credit value (Table 2). Natural Regeneration Establishment (Category 1), was second in area at 26% but accounted for only 7 percent of total credit value claimed in 2001 (Table 2). Categories 1 to 5 all had at least 10% of claimed area, and only Categories 6 and 7 each contributing less than 1% of total area claimed in 2001 (Table 2). Softwood silviculture completed on all private lands was 97 percent of the total credit value claimed in year 2001 (Table 3).

A breakdown of completed silviculture by category and ownership is described in Table 4. Private woodlot silviculture value claimed in the Wood Acquisition Plans for 2001 totaled 6.158 million credits (Table 4), an increase of 91% from 2000. An additional 0.63 million dollars of silviculture was completed on private woodlots through the pilot silviculture program operated by the Association of Sustainable Forestry with DNR silviculture funding in year 2001. Total private woodlot silviculture value completed in 2001 was 6.8 million. Industrial silviculture claimed through Wood Acquisition Plans for year 2001 totaled 7.3 million credits (Table 4), an increase of 45% compared to year 2000. Total private land silviculture value in year 2001 from Wood Acquisition Plans reports and other funding sources totaled 14.1 million.

A summary of completed silviculture area claimed in year 2001 by silviculture category, ownership and species type is included in Table 5.
