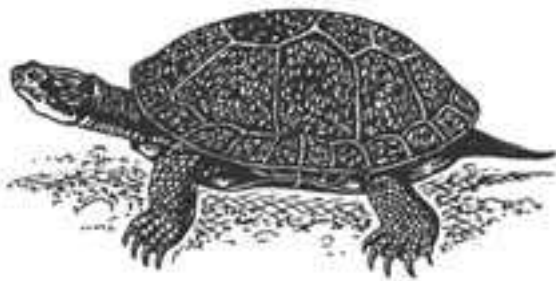


# Species at Risk
