

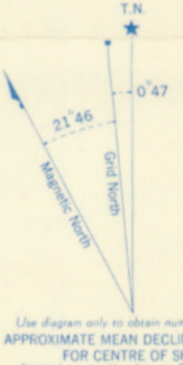

REFERENCE

- Roads:
 - hard surface, heavy duty: 3 or more lanes, Part completed
 - hard surface, heavy duty: 2 lanes, 24' route No.
 - hard surface, medium duty: 3 or more lanes, 2 lanes
 - loose surface, graded and drained: 3 or more lanes, Not less than 14ft wide
 - Other Roads: 2 lanes, Poor condition
- Trail or Portage: Station, Stop, Siding
- Railways: double track, single track, abandoned
- Bridges: narrow gauge, or electric cutting; embankment
- overpass; underpass
- Boundaries: International, Province or State, County or District, Township or Parish, Reservation; Park, etc.
- Surveyed Line: on Steel Towers, on Wood Poles
- Electric Power Line: Telephone Line, trunk route
- Triangulation Station
- Boundary Mon., Survey Mon.
- Bench Mark: Spot Elevation, (in feet) 782
- Building: Barn, Mill or Factory, small; Sawmill, etc. SM
- Church; Cemetery
- School; Post Office
- Mine or Open Cut
- Quarry
- Sand or Gravel Pit
- Lake or Pond, intermittent
- Lake or Shoreline, indefinite
- Stream, intermittent or dry
- Stream, indefinite
- Irrigation Canal or Ditch
- Marsh or swamp
- Inundated Land
- Falls; Rapids
- Foreshore Flats
- Bluff, Cliff or Escarpment
- Lighthouse
- Wharf or Pier; Ferry
- Contours: elevation, depression, approximate, Orchard, Wooded Area
