








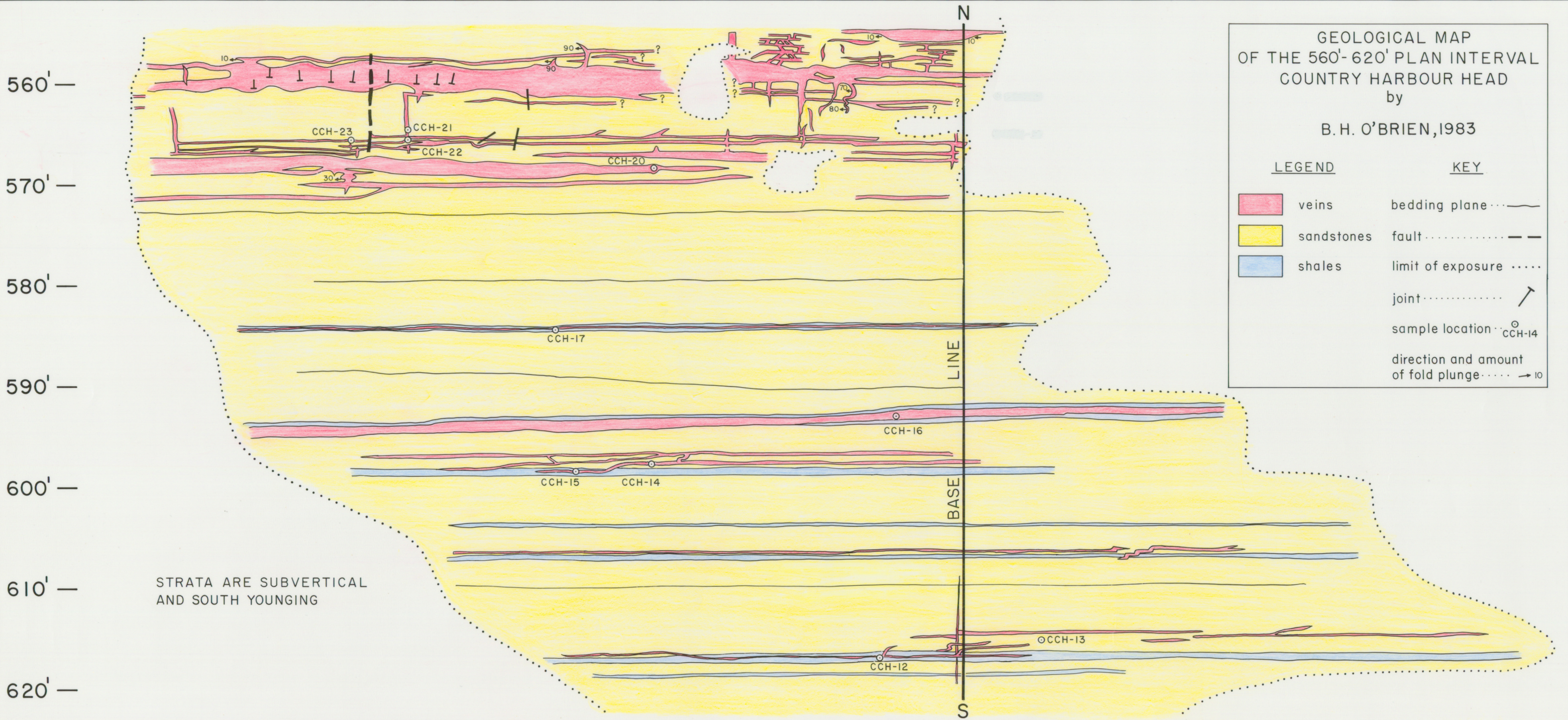


GEOLOGICAL MAP
