This map shows the location, size and distribution of protected and limited use lands in Nova Scotia. These areas bear land use classifications which prohibit or restrict mineral resource exploitation and development.

Thirteen protected and limited use land classifications are identified. These include land use categories represented areas considered to be unique because of their biophysical, historical or cultural characteristics.

Some restrictive land use classifications are supported by law while others are defended by their custodians or by public opinion. A colour code identifies the level of protection conveyed by each land use classification. Red signifies no access for exploration allowed, green indicates possible permission for access through negotiation with the appropriate agencies.

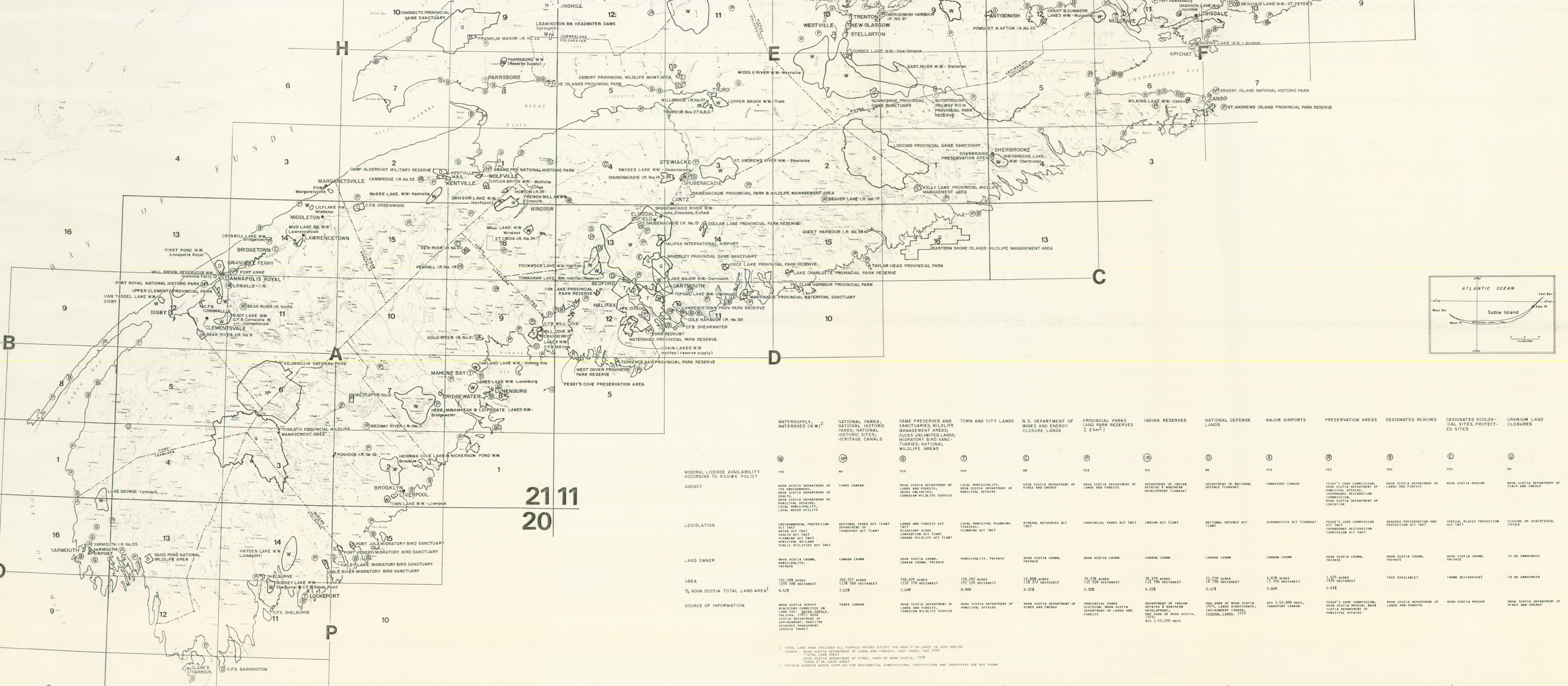
