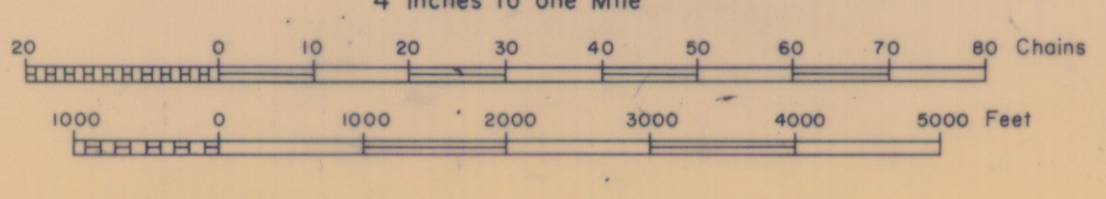
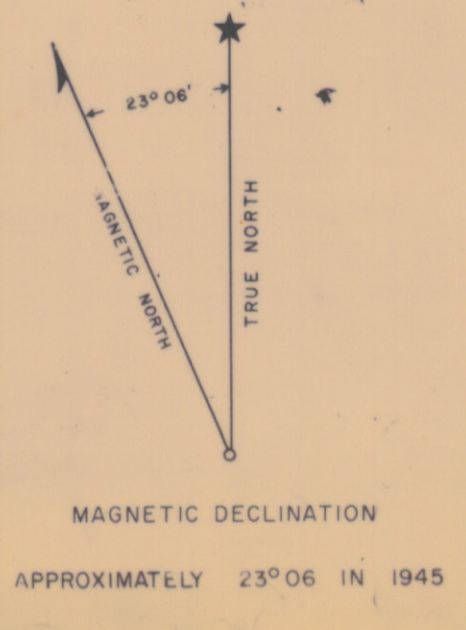


NINE MILE RIVER
