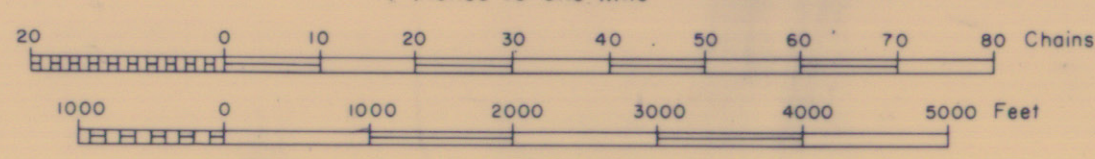




SOUTH PORT MORIEN
