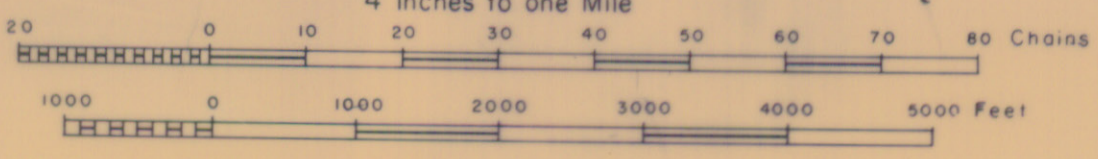


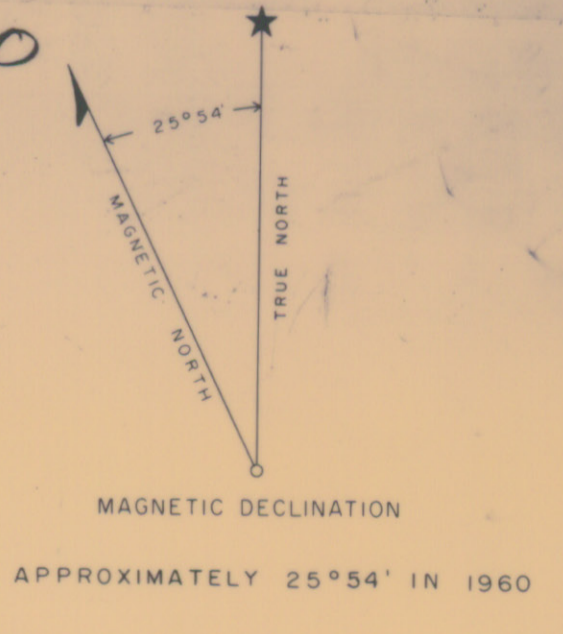


CAP PERCE
