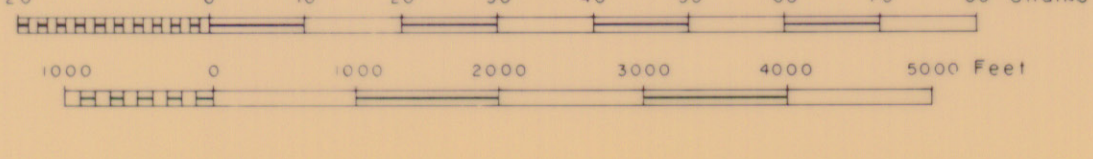


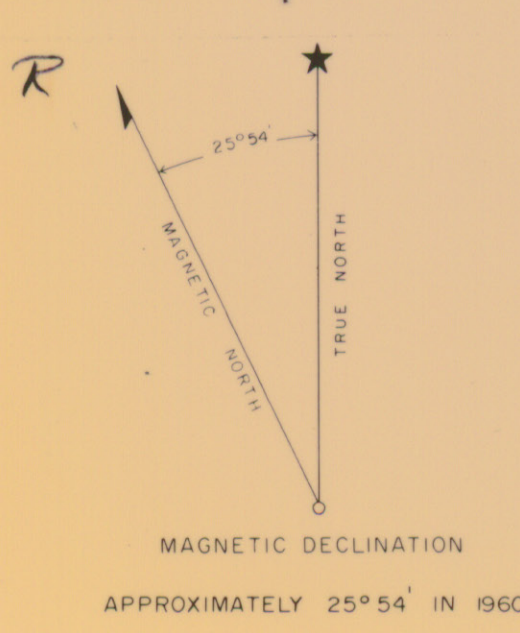
FLORENCE
