

The top of the cliff or bank (in its natural state) was interpreted and digitized by Mineral Resources Branch staff, Nova Scotia Department of Natural Resources (NSDNR) from georeferenced 1:10 000 aerial photography taken in July 2005. The Mean High Water Mark coastline was extracted from the NSTDB and adjusted locally by Mineral Resources Branch staff from the same georeferenced aerial photography. The location of the old Joggins Wharf used to define the Lower Cove Protectected Beach was interpreted from georeferenced aerial photography from November 1967.






