

## **PERSONAL PETS EXOTIC WILDLIFE PROHIBITION LIST**

Pursuant to Section 113 (1) (at ) and (au) of the Wildlife Act, R.S.N.S. 1989, c504 and Section 6 of the General Wildlife Regulations, The Director of Wildlife has determined the following wildlife species or groups of wildlife species and their hybrids may not be kept as personal pets or imported into the province for use as personal pets:

1. Wild boar
2. Prairie dogs
3. All Canidae (except the domestic dog)
4. All Hyaenidae (Hyenas)
5. All Ursidae (Bears)
6. All Cervidae (Deer)
7. All Felidae (except the domestic cat)
8. All Crocodylians (such as alligators and crocodiles)
9. All Mustelidae (except the domestic ferret)
10. All Procyonidae (such as raccoons, coatis and cacomistles)
  - (a) Captive Wildlife Permit may be issued in extenuating circumstances for native raccoons.
11. All Pteropodidae (bats)
12. All Viverridae (such as mongooses, civets and genets)
13. All Marsupials (except sugar gliders)
14. All Primates
15. All Venomous animals (including those with toxin removed)

<i>Python molurus molurus</i>	Indian python
<i>Morelia amethystina</i>	Amethyst python

- a. A Captive Wildlife Permit may be issued for the large Boidae to people who have demonstrated understanding of proper husbandry techniques and who have appropriate facilities.
